ADA Transition Plan Policy

1. Purpose

The purpose of the policy is to adopt the New York State Office of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation's ADA Transition Plan as amended herein to serve as the official ADA Transition Plan for the Westchester County Department of Parks, Recreation & Conservation.

2. Policy

- a. **Background** - In accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), state and local governments are obligated to conduct a self-assessment of their facilities, programs and services. Agencies must create an ADA Transition Plan to address those barriers identified in the self-assessment. The New York State Office of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation conducted its own self-assessment and established an ADA Transition Plan for State parks and recreation areas in June of 2015.
- B. **Disposition** - The Westchester County Department Parks, Recreation and Conservation (PRC) has conducted its own self-assessment of parks and recreation facilities within Westchester County and has adopted the State Parks ADA Transition Plan as amended herein to ensure that there is no discrimination against individuals on the basis of disability in its programs and services and to address and eliminate structural barriers associated with County parks and recreation facilities.
