NOT-FOR-PROFIT FEE STRUCTURE FOR PARK RENTALS

For groups <u>under 250</u>, using the park as a fundraising opportunity, it is required to obtain a permit which will include: A facility usage fee of \$500 which will cover the cost of one staff person and usage of the facility for the event. If police are needed to be hired or any other equipment is needed for the event the fee structure will change. A \$500 security deposit is also required and will be returned at the conclusion of the event unless more than 250 people attend or if the park site is not left in a clean and orderly state, as determined by a County Parks employee. A certificate of insurance will also be needed. Please contact the Parks Dept Permit Office at (914) 231-4575. For an event of <u>250-500</u> participants, the same guidelines would be followed but the facility usage fee would be \$1,000 plus the required \$500 security deposit.

For an event over <u>500</u> participants, the same guidelines would be followed but the facility usage fee would be \$10,000. If the group is a 501c3 not-for-profit organization the fee would be \$3,000.
