The attached Resolution is being submitted pursuant to the Emergency Declaration that was submitted to vour Honorable Board on October 7 2021.

On September 2, 2021 the Westchester County Center experienced flooding in the lower level due to Hurricane Ida, which left the electrical transformer underwater and created a fire hazard. The facility had to be immediately de-energized, cleaned and pumped to clear out water, then tested and reenergized for safety and for a timely return to operations of the County Center as a COVID vaccination site.

It was determined by the Department of Public Works and Transportation, as well as the Department of Emergency Services, that an electrician was needed on an emergency basis to repair the electrical transformer and prepare the building to be re-energized.

As noted in the Memorandum, the Department of Public Works and Transportation (the "Department"), following its standard emergency contract protocols, selected the firm of Healy Electric Contracting, Inc., 4 Fisher Lane, White Plains New York 10603 to perform Contract 21-208 Emergency Electrical Service, Westchester County Center, 198 Central Avenue, White Plains, New York. The emergency work performed under this contract included all necessary labor, material and equipment required for re-energizing the building after the storm, repairing electrical gear, establishing emergency lighting and power, and replacing electrical outlets that had filled with water and sludge.

The total cost of the work is \$35,350.38. The Department has reviewed Healy Electric Contracting, Inc.'s line item breakdown for the work and has determined that the costs are consistent with similar items of work on other County Projects.
