

2020 Nature Center Summer Camp Survey Results

- 46 total respondents
 - o 10 Cranberry
 - o 10 Marshlands
 - o 26 Lenoir
- 19 families had attended camp before, 27 were new to NC camps
- When asked if their children enjoyed camp, 41 respondents were <u>overall</u> "Very satisfied" (90%)
 6 respondents "Satisfied"



• 41 respondents "Very satisfied" with <u>safety precautions</u>, 3 "Satisfied", 2 "Neither satisfied or dissatisfied" – 2 comments regarding mask breaks for kids.

• <u>Weather</u> cancellations/dismissals were a big stressor this summer but respondents agreed with our strategy.



- 42 (91%) were very satisfied with the <u>teachers/staff</u>; 3 were satisfied, 1 was "neither satisfied nor dissatisfied".
- As usual, there were requests for longer days and earlier drop-offs, but plurality thought <u>hours</u> were very satisfactory. A couple requests for Marshlands to go back to full day.
 - o 19 strongly agreed hours were convenient
 - o 17 agreed
 - o 8 were ambivalent
 - o 2 disagreed
- Registration, refunds, and communication were the biggest non-directly COVID concern, but still 84% were either 'Very satisfied' or 'Satisfied'. 2 respondents were 'Dissatisfied'. Specifics

mentioned were website related, delayed refunds, and unanswered phone calls.




 Outdoor time and learning about nature remain the primary <u>reasons</u> for sending kids to our camps.

"My children seemed to even happier with their camp experience this year. They were signed up for a variety of camps including golf, sports, and Muscoot. However, they both agreed that Lenoir was the best of them all."

"My younger said it was very different. My older (CIT) said it was "kind of different" but other than being vigilant about how close one stood to one another, it was not terribly different. She laments that they were not able to have the overnight for obvious reasons."

"9AM starts are hard for working parents. My meetings/work day start at 9AM, so an 8:45 drop off is preferred so I can be in front of my computer at 9AM. In non-coronavirus times, I have to get into the city for work, and on the 8:08 train out of Hastings. So in regular times, early drop off options would be really needed. It's really hard/inconvenient to find a sitter to come in the morning for just 1 hour. "

"Level of engagement is off the charts. So excited to attend, happy to share what he learned."

"It was so amazing that this camp opened safely during pandemic. It was even better than last year."

"Director Scott is very engaging and clearly loves the outdoors, counselors are good, i love the activires and the fact that kids can explore some on their own. Love that they are outdoors the whole time despite
