Dear Colleagues,

Within just a few short weeks, the weather will grow cooler, and the leaves will turn color and fall. We will begin our retreat indoors as the summer months come to a close, and begin preparations to celebrate the holidays with our family and friends.

That's why I'm being proactive and taking the time to schedule my flu shot right now, to ensure I am protected throughout flu season. We strongly encourage all of you to do the same.

Our Westchester County Health Department has been hard at work securing flu vaccine for County employees, to make it easy and convenient to get your shot while you're at work. **To that end, the Westchester County Health Department will begin holding free flu vaccine clinics for County employees beginning on Tuesday, October 3.**

The clinics have been scheduled in a number of our Westchester County Office Buildings. Attached to this email are full instructions on how to register, and make an appointment online. If you do not have internet access you may call (914) 995-7425, during business hours, to schedule an appointment. Should these locations not be convenient for you, we encourage you to schedule your flu vaccine through CVS or through your local medical provider.

Dependents and County retirees with UMR health insurance are also welcome to attend most clinics; please refer to the schedule attached.

Please wear clothing that allows easy access to your arm, and arrive at least five minutes prior to your scheduled appointment time. If on the day of your appointment you are experiencing COVID-like symptoms or not feeling well, you must reschedule your appointment.

If your schedule allows, please make an appointment to get your flu shot today – just make sure you check in with your supervisor first. Stay healthy.
